Changing a Database Name Using NEWID

One of the many tasks a DBA will perform is cloning a database. Usually this is done from a production database to a quality assurance or test database to provide production volume data. If the database is on a virtual machine, cloning could occur at the VM level.

Cloning does exactly what it means, creating an exact duplicate of a database. Unfortunately, that ends up with you having two databases with the same name and DBID in your network. Sometimes you can resolve it sufficiently with aliasing at the TNSNAMES level. Read More
